The fourth installation of the exhibition series *A synchroni-city* is presenting the Dutch architect Rajan V. Ritoe, director of *RITOE architecture – urbanism – infrastucture* and *Terraventure – network for innovative urban research*.

The global investigating of hybrid conditions and systems pursued by Ritoe is highly topical and innovative. His projects emphasizes experimental approaches that give form to new and unprecedented visions. During the last five years Ritoe engages in experimentation on various (perceptual) levels, pursuing a kind of basic research into the relationship between individual and space.

Accumulations of different elements in time and space are strictly analysed and become transformed into artistic-architectural visions. Ritoe deals with several disciplines: art, architecture, sociology and design. He involves new methods of research and creates innovative concomitant apparatuses, tools and sensibility of perception and experience.

The exhibition concept is based on the insights of the international Terraventure workshops in Buenos Aires, Barcelona and Tokyo. Hybridity in different scales is joined in several objects which will be especially developed for the exhibition.

The **opening reception** will take place on **Saturday July 21 2007 at 4 pm**.

The exhibition will be accompanied by an English language *Happy Talk* on the topic '*Hybrid Designing in Urban Context*' from Rajan V. Ritoe.
